

Lesson10<比較2>

Point 1 more, most を用いる表現

◎ 長いつづりの形容詞や副詞の比較級には more、最上級には most を用いる。

① 比較級 <more 形容詞・副詞>

[比較] This flower is more beautiful than that one. (形容詞)

He walks more slowly than Bob. (副詞)

② 最上級 <the most 形容詞・副詞>

[比較] Baseball is the most popular sport in Japan. (形容詞)

He drives a car the most carefully of us all. (副詞)

③ more, most を用いる形容詞・副詞

- ・<形容詞> …beautiful, careful, useful, interesting, popular, difficult など
- ・<副詞> …slowly, carefully, quickly, happily など

Point 2 いろいろな比較表現

① <Which(who) ~ 比較級, A or B?> 「A と B とでは、どちらがより～か。」

[例] Who is taller, Ken or Taro? / Taro is.

Which do you like better, coffee or tea? / I like tea better.

② <比較級 than any other 単数名詞> 「他のどの…よりも～だ。」

[例] Mt. Fuji is higher than any other mountain in Japan.

= Mt. Fuji is the highest mountain in Japan.

③ <one of the 最上級 複数名詞> 「最も～…のうちの1つ」

[例] Tokyo is one of the biggest cities in the world.

④ <… times as 原級 as> 「…倍の～だ。」

[例] This river is three times as long as that one. ※ 2倍→twice

⑤ <単位を表す名詞 比較級 than …> 「…より一だけ～だ。」

[例] He is three years older than you.

⑥ <比較級 and 比較級> 「だんだん(ますます)～」

[例] It got darker and darker.
